Notes to Participants – Adult Courses 2017

Sailing gear: The club can provide a limited number and sizes of wetsuits and kag/spray top or buoyancy aids to sailing course trainees, but it is preferable that trainees bring their own **wetsuit, dinghy boots, buoyancy aid (life jacket), waterproof spray top (kag) where possible** and warm dry clothing and footwear for use when on land.

Lunch: Please ensure you bring plenty of lunch and water. Sailing and being on the water is exhausting (low GI carbohydrates are recommended) and dehydrating. High factor sunscreen, hat and sunglasses are also advisable as damage can be caused even on dull days on the water.

Times: Course times may vary from those advertised. There will be days when weather conditions will prevent some or all trainees going on the water. This cannot be avoided and either the course will be rescheduled or shore-based activities may be organised in lieu.

Medical issues or learning difficulties: It is imperative for the safety of you, your child, other trainees and instructors on the course that GSC is made aware of any issues you may have. Any declaration will be treated in the strictest confidence and shared only on a 'need to know' basis.

Achievements: Emphasis in GSC is on **having FUN in a SAFE and learning environment**. The learning element refers to the attainment, at a consistent level, of skills which may or may not be required to acquire certificate, depending on the course. **For water based courses**, time on the water, and attention to instruction will achieve this at different rates depending on the trainees, their commitment and weather conditions. In all cases, **time on the water**, outside of course hours will certainly reinforce learning and speed up skills acquisition. Club boats are available to members for Club sailing on Wednesday evenings, Saturday afternoons, Sunday mornings and when coaching but subject to skill level and wind conditions. On short courses or where trainees only attend a part of the course, weather conditions and time constraints may restrict the ability for instruction in all areas of the syllabus and hence skills acquisition.

It is GSC and ISA policy to only award a certificate when the participant is proficient. The ISA syllabi for the Small Boat Sailing Scheme (SBSS) and National Powerboat Certificate is detailed from a link on our website.

To save time, please ensure the email address section is complete. Courses may fill early. Call me with any queries and to ensure there is a space available.

1. Complete the application form and declaration and post to GSC.

2. In your e-banking account transfer option, enter the following details:
