

NOTICE OF RACE



27th and 28th August 2022

The Greystones Sailing Club "Taste Of Greystones" Cruiser Regatta will be held at Greystones Sailing Club, Saturday 27th August and Sunday 28th August 2022.

1.0 ORGANISING AUTHORITY

2.0 RULES AND ELIGIBILITY

2.1 The Regatta will be governed by the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing 2017 – 2020 (RRS), the prescriptions of the Irish Sailing Association (ISA), the ISA ECHO Performance Handicap System, the ISAF/ORC Safety Regulations Category 4, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions and any amendments thereto.

2.2 Entries are accepted at the sole discretion of the Organising Committee.

3.0 DIVISIONS/CLASSES

3.1 Racing will be scored under fixed standard echo.

3.2 Boats will be divided as follows on the basis of their standard ECHO.

ECHO Class I Ratings of 0.980 and above

ECHO Class II Ratings of 0.900 – 0.979

ECHO Class III Ratings 0.899 and below

ECHO Class IV White Sails Fleet – No Spinnaker

(subject to the Race Committee's right to allocate a boat to any Class)

Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in all classes

The Handicap Bands for the Classes are provisional and may be subject to change by the Race Committee up to 2 hours before Race 1, to provide an even spread of boats in the Classes.

4.0 SCHEDULE OF RACES

4.1 The schedule of races will be as follows:

Race 1 Saturday 27th August - Warning signal at 15.25

Two races will be held on Sunday 28th August - Warning signal at 10.55

A target time of 14.30 for completion of two races on Sunday has been set and prize giving is targeted for 15.30 to allow visiting boats reasonable departure time.

The Organising Authority reserves the right to amend the Schedule of Races

5.0 SCORING

The Low Point scoring system of Appendix A of the RRS will apply. One race is required to be completed to constitute a series. When all races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her 3 race scores.

6.0 ENTRIES

Entries shall be made by completing the Eventbrite form online at GSC.ie or completing the entry form available on GSC.IE and returning the form to Greystones Sailing Club. Entries are accepted at the sole discretion of the Organising Authority.

Entry Fees: All Classes €75.00

Entry includes Free marina voucher, Complimentary drink vouchers for Beach House PLUS FREE Saturday Dinner, Sunday Breakfast and Prize Giving Lunch.

7.0 SAIL NUMBERS

Each boat shall show a distinguishing number on each side of its mainsail, which shall be the same number as declared on the Entry Form.

8.0 HANDICAPS

ECHO handicaps will be published on the official notice board outside the race office not later than 14.00 Saturday 27th August.

9.0 PRIZES/TROPHIES

Prizes will be awarded in each Class and will consist of 2nd, 3rd and overall prizes and trophies.

10.0 REGISTRATION AND SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

All entrants shall register with the Race Office in the Greystones sailing club management offices upon arrival. Sailing Instructions, Race card, Vouchers and Visitor Information will be available on registration and may be posted on the website prior to the event. The Pre-Event Race Office hours are:

Saturday 27th August 11.00 – 14.30

It is important to register early to allow clarity of all boat handicaps.

11.0 RACING AREA

Races will be sailed in Greystones area, South of Bray Head and North of Breeches Mark.

12.0 BERTHING

Entry includes free overnight berth in Greystones Marina Saturday 27th August.

Early entry is strongly encouraged to assist in the management of an expected large fleet. Only boats actually racing on Saturday qualify for the complementary regatta berth and will require a marina voucher available at registration.
